The Wills Group shares plans for Historic Day House property on Stringtown Rd

The November monthly breakfast meeting featured a briefing on proposed development of 23200 Stringtown Road in the Clarksburg Historic District. The developer, [The Wills Group](#), provided aerial photos, property maps, and design renderings of their project – a Dash In convenience store (with full grill and outside seating), fueling station, and car wash. All would be accessed from Stringtown Road.



The Historic Day House on the corner (currently boarded-up) would be preserved with some restoration to prevent additional loss. Additional restoration is contingent on finding a tenant for the property, perhaps a law firm or similar light-use business.

The Wills Group has already invested 18 months of concept development, design, permitting, and reviews. They anticipate another 18 months of similar activities before breaking ground.
